ULTRAFILTRATION PILOT PROJECT**

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the supply of Ultrafiltration Pilot Unit to the **Town of Indian Lake, Ultrafiltration Pilot Project** will be received by the Town at the **Town of Indian Lake, P.O. Box 730, 117 Pelon Rd, Indian Lake, NY 12842**, until **3:00 P.M.** local time on **Wednesday, September 14, 2022**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The proposed scope of supply and services includes, but is not necessarily limited to:

- Provide water treatment pilot skid (ultrafiltration system) including pilot system, feed and backwash storage tanks, feed/CIP recirculation and backwash pump, pressure gauges and transmitters, flowmeters, pH sensor and transmitter, temperature sensor and transmitter, feed and filtrate turbidimeters, air compressor unit, pre-programmed PLC, data logger, all piping, valves, internal electrical components and mounting structures.
- Setup, operational assistance and decommissioning of pilot:
 - Technical representative for 2 days for setup and initial operation.
 - Technical representative for 2 days for CIP assistance and discretionary trip.
 - Technical representative for 2 days for pilot cleaning and takedown and packaging.
- Maintain data obtained from on-site pilot testing and review and evaluate results of testing data. Provide final report of pilot study to summarize results and ability of the proposed unit to meet the study objectives.

Prospective bidders shall comply with all requirements and permitting set forth within the Contract Documents. The project is being funded by a NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation WIIA Grant and SRF Loan, and prospective bidders shall comply with all provisions within the EFC Mandatory Terms & Conditions included within the Project Manual. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis for **Contract No. TIL-2022-P** as indicated in the Bid Form.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents are available as portable document format (PDF) files for a refundable charge of **\$25**. Alternatively, printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The refundable cost of printed Bidding Documents is **\$95** per set, payable to "Cedarwood Engineering Services PLLC", plus a non-refundable shipping charge. All costs associated with mailing/shipping for printed Bidding Documents are at the bidder's expense. Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery method of choice; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 30 days after receipt of Bids will receive a full refund. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Addenda, if any, will be issued only to those companies whose name and address are on record with Cedarwood Engineering as having obtained the Contract Documents.

All bids must be made on the official Bid Form or an exact copy by reproduction thereof and enclosed in a sealed envelope. No bidder may withdraw their bid within forty-five calendar days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of five percent of the maximum bid price, as determined by adding the base bid and all alternatives, in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The successful bidder will be required to comply with all provisions of the Federal Government Equal Employment Opportunity clauses issued by the Secretary of Labor on May 21, 1968 and published in the Federal Register (41CFR Part 60-1, 33 F.2 7804).
