First, we are hoping the project will begin at the end of March this year (2024). They have until September of 2025 to finish; however, we all know that this is a tentative date for completion. While we are not anticipating any problems you never know what they will run into once the project begins.

Some questions were asked at the Monday night meeting such as:

1. Bogs: no bogs will be removed during the project.
2. Byron Park and Pavilion will be closed for the duration of the project as it will be used as a staging and for equipment.
3. There will be NO boat access once the project begins. We are hoping to allow this on the other side of Byron Park, but at this time we cannot be certain we will be able to do this.
4. The Lake will be drawn down anywhere from 8 to 10 inches.
5. All events currently being held there are being moved to a different location. I do not have that information for you at this time.
6. All organizations that use Byron Park building were given this information last year and those that have called have been moved to the ski hit.
